The Chatham plant's success can be attributed to having design, development and manufacturing all located under one roof. Dana's customers can be assured that their requests are handled quickly through this dynamic business philosophy. Dana has a highly skilled and dedicated workforce.

The 85,000 square foot facility is home to 52 employees who operate two shifts. These employees are active in their community by donating both financially and through volunteer hours to the United Way and Relay for Life. They are proud supporters of the Branch 128 Poppy Fund, and sponsor numerous minor sports and school activities.

In addition to having obtained ISO 14001, TS 16949, and Ford Q1 designations, Dana has also received the GM Platinum Supplier Status, GM QSB, and the Navistar Supplier Awards. This innovative company predicts a 40% growth in sales over the next three years.
