AND WHEREAS in 2001 Bill Parks was selected as the Chatham & District Chamber of Commerce's "Agriculturalist of the Year", and in 2008 the business was selected as the Chatham-Kent Chamber's "Entrepreneur of the Year", and Bill Parks has been made an Honourary Member of the Canadian Seed Trade;

AND WHEREAS the business owners/operators are a part of numerous organizations, including the Ontario Fruit and Vegetable Growers, the Ontario Berry Growers, the Ontario Highbush Blueberry Growers, etc. and, in some instances have held positions on the Boards of those organizations;
